Mendip RC Raceway was first opened for on road radio controlled car racing in 1977, by the Rallycross legend John Button. Since then it has been the home of on-road racing in the South West, hosting both national and international competitions and to this day still aims to be one of the finest RC car racing facilities in the UK. With the addition of the 1/10th electric off road track in 2012, it now caters for racers across the RC spectrum.

The site boasts undercover pitting for 70 racers, hardstanding areas for gazebos for pitting and surrounding grass areas for camping and a large car parking area.

The off road track is an astroturf all weather track that takes advantage of the natural undulations of the terrain to give a unique racing surface. Landscaping the track in 2018 saw almost half the track being made more uniform to allow various



layouts to be used and to extend the track by over twelve square metres.

The track is designed to allow the use of multiple layouts and has the distinctive banked corner and the iconic “tree stump” features which can be used in different layouts to ensure something unique can be created for every event.

Camping

Camping can be booked and paid for via our website. Camping fees must be paid in advance – standard camping £7.50 per tent per night, caravan pitches are £8.50 per caravan per night.

The camping areas are not managed by the club, but the club acts as a intermediary for arranging bookings and payment for camping, these **must** be made via the clubs website.

Accessibility

Most of our site is on one level so can be easily accessed by those with mobility concerns. Our rostrum has twin handrails on both the up and down stairs. Unfortunately it does not lend itself to wheelchair users. It is the clubs aim to be as accessible as possible to all RC racers so if there is a specific need or requirement then please contact us and we will try to accommodate any requests.
